PROJECT MARKETING COMPONENTS HUMAN RESOURCE – A TERM COINED IN THE 1960S

Human resources is a relatively modern management term, coined in the 1960s. The origins of the function arose in organizations that introduced 'welfare management' practices and also in those that adopted the principles of 'scientific management'. From these terms emerged a largely administrative management activity, coordinating a range of worker related processes and becoming known, in time as the 'personnel function'. Human resources progressively became the more usual name for this function, in the first instance in the United States as well as multinational corporations. reflecting the adoption of a more quantitative as well as strategic approach to workforce management, demanded by corporate management and the greater competitiveness for limited and highly skilled workers. In 2011, national statics on high school seniors found only 52% met reading, 45% met math, and 30% met Science test score requirements for college readiness. The decline may be the result of a missing national rally calling on a generation to pursue STEM studies that we once had in early 1960's. The Cold War ushered on robust competition in science and technology to make us contenders in the space race with the Soviet Union. American's had a patriotic urgency in STEM learning to vie against the USSR. Astronauts and NASA space centers held an awesome draw factor to young school students. Behind this interest was also the mandated government educational funding for STEM careers. These things helped fuel STEM field electives. The decline in STEM is a dilemma that the US Government is now addressing in our schools. Nongovernment organizations are also carrying the torch for STEM. In 1998 the AAUW -American Association of University Women, a nonprofit membership org conducted their own school research studies and found the lack of interest in acquiring STEM proficiencies was even greater among girls. AAUW of New Jersey's solution was to get high school girls interested in STEM programs with engaging girl focused projects at their workshop convention called teentech[™] held at a host college campus. Besides the partnership with a New Jersey host college and participating high schools, they also found collaboration with other organizations such as the IEEE of New Jersey. More professional orgs are taking STEM discovery projects into local schools. They know the future of a nation depends on the studies school children take an interest in.
